Legal Counsel

Responsibilities

- Structure and draft agreements, amendments, addenda, and other documents to comply with new and existing regulatory responsibilities and commercial contracts.
- Provide legal advice and counsel to business units and other stakeholders on current and potential legal and commercial issues of the business.

- Stay on top of changing business regulations, relevant industry trends, and work with business, finance, technology, and legal stakeholders to develop and implement best practices.
