- Respond to internal/external audits and regulatory inquiries/examinations.
- Engage with Nodal management and staff to address clearing house compliance/regulatory matters.
- Prepare reports and presentations for management.
- Coordinate and prepare regulatory filings.
- Review and help maintain compliance policies and procedures.
- Correspond with regulators on routine matters.
- Obtain a thorough understanding of the policies and procedures that apply to various business units.
